Updates:

- Green Acres creek walk and meeting with neighborhood association – June 2008
- Discussion of needs of the Green Acres area
- From discussion a community cleanup (UK Fusion) was initiated in Green Acres Park
- From discussion an engineering meeting occurred: discussion of movement of pipes, soil...Attendees included UK, LFUCG, CDP Engineers, Ecogro . Meeting allowed everyone to be “on the same page” in terms of projects, and how various projects will impact one another.
- Jim R.– Wellhead Connection Committee should be informed – need brief meeting about what is happening
- Lexmark –Frank discussed site wide assessment of all Lexmark water systems, stream restoration project in park, and how various projects interact and affect one another; Lexmark held cleanup this past spring
- CDP – Dave discussed grant from state that addresses drainage, storm water problems in Green Acres. CDP is doing study to see what can be done in neighborhood. Discussed survey that had been conducted. Contact was attempted with each neighborhood resident. Issues: trash, water quality,

sanitary sewer, flooding by surface water, storm drainage. Green Acres and Winburn are two largest areas that they are dealing with.

- Swim modeling – computer model system for storm water management (how wide, deep, intense). Use data from actual storm events. June 1992 was major storm event in Lexington. 1992 – 2004, 7 of 10 major storm events occurred during this time in Lex. April 2008 was major storm event. In phase of identifying problems.
- UK – Steve – meeting provide communication. UK will add education materials (what is storm water).
- UK – Amanda – UK has installed several monitoring stations. Carmen is conducting collecting and analyzing samples. This data will be put into watershed based plan. BMPs have been installed at UK Farm (stream crossings, alternative watering systems, riparian areas, invasive removal). Plan to do some planting there in future.

#### Future Plans

- TFCE – Winburn school investigating insects and their interaction in the Cane Run Watershed
- Winburn Community Center – Carol – had meeting with Katrina Lewis at Community Action Center – from meeting – want to do education in systematic way, trying to reach young students in informal and formal settings.
- Carol discussed Water Ambassador Program, and starting program in Cane Run
  - Katrina gave Carol several contacts within the community
  - Next step is how can we touch all young people in Cane Run and how can they all become water ambassadors
  - Ken – do we have any support within the school board? Carol – Kelly Breeding (Facilities), David Helm, Lori Bowen, Superintendent Silverman, Jack Hayes
  - Amanda – want to make sure we include the parents
  - Jim Embry is having rain garden workshop on first Saturday in October
  - Amanda met with Green Acres Neighborhood Association – Cane Run Watershed Council needs to put together proposal on how we would like to contribute to their meetings – if anyone wants to help with that contact Amanda (meetings are first Mondays of the month at Green Acres Community Center)
  - Councilman will send Carol name of teacher at Russell Cave
  - Amanda – can we bring students from Winburn to Lexmark for water sampling? Frank – YES
  - Steve Workman – look at Loudon Ave section is more urban setting
- South Scott Co sewer lines
- Toyota's environmental initiatives were discussed
- Discussion of 25 and 460 corridor
- City Council – discussion of running sewer out to county line; discussed addition study
- Roy - Discussion of City Council – will group consider talking with City Council regarding packaging plants, and installing sewers along 25 corridor
- Need an adopted land use plan
- New growth and existing development are problems

- Health Dept and Planning and Zoning have to be called in to make assessments (health issues, zoning issue)
- May want to approach new council members after elections – Scott Co
- Mostly ag. (Carolyn Oldfield's group) is doing the most – Scott Co
- Between now and election time – get a good feel about how we would like to approach situation in Scott Co and who the major players are – can we do this by email so we can include Health Dept folks and DOC folks
- What is Cane Run Watershed Council's role? – Mandy answered – main goal is to have discussion, and secondly to take action – we are the voice of the watershed
